

| | MESHACH (EARTH GOD) [MISHAEL] | THE SUBSTITUTED NAME RETAINS A PART OF THE WORD, DISPLACING THE LAST SYLLABLE, WHICH IS THE NAME OF JEHOVAH, BY THE NAME "SHAK," THE CHIEF GODDESS OF BABYLON, THE GODDESS OF BEAUTY AND PLEASURE. |
